4. Acceptance by Administrator

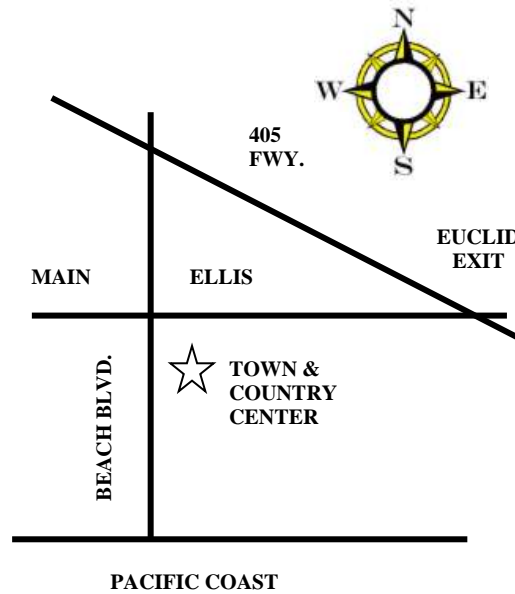
## **APPROVAL STATUS**
