STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Each student is obligated to officially withdraw from classes that he/she has enrolled in with an official cancellation form given to the Administration office.

Cancellations of program contracts shall occur when you give a written notice of cancellation. You can do this by mail, or hand delivery, or facsimile. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail and properly addressed with postage. Currently we are not accepting cancellation of contracts or from program classes via email, but faxed or scanned copies will also be accepted.

The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that you no longer wish to be enrolled in the class. Refund of any tuition amount paid for the courses will be determined by the Director and issued to the student within 45 days after the cancellation notice is received. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of money not paid from student financial aid program funds.
